Renshi Steve Wolfrom

4th Degree Black Belt - YonDan



Renshi Wolfrom was born and raised in Ft. Lauderdale, Florida. He has one son, who is the reason that he began training in Martial Arts in February of 1992. Unlike most people who start training in their younger years, Renshi was well into adulthood when he had his first taste of the art that would become a major part of his life.

Renshi's training began in Ju-Jitsu under then Master Marty Ferrick. He earned his First Degree Black Belt in June of 1995. Now, Soke Marty Ferrick, Grand Master of the Mizu Ryu Ju-Jitsu System, awarded Steve his current rank of Yon Dan and title of Renshi in December of 2003. He is currently the third highest rank of active Mizu Ryu practitioners.

Training in the Inayan System of Eskrima began early in 1999 under the instruction of Mangisursuro Mike Inay, the founder of the system. Magnisursuro passed away in September of 2000. Training continues today under the tutelage of Suro Jason Inay and Soke Marty Ferrick. Renshi Wolfrom currently holds the equivalent rank of Black Belt in Inayan Eskrima.

In October of 2002 Steve became certified in F.A.S.T. (Forced Adrenal Stress Training) Defense, a method of training primarily non-martial artists how to recognize a threat, its level of intensity, and how to deal with that threat.

Renshi Wolfrom participates in demonstrations and seminars promoting and instructing in Mizu-Ryu Ju-Jitsu, Inayan Eskrima and F.A.S.T. Defense. As a result of the open mindedness of his instructor, Soke Marty Ferrick, he has been exposed to and had the opportunity to train in an eclectic collection of different arts and styles.

Renshi Wolfrom was inducted into the World Head of Family Sokeship Council International Hall of Fame as an Associate Member in May of 2006.
